Proper framing cannot only visually enhance your artistic endeavors; it also lets the show curators know just how serious you are about your chosen profession.

Yes, art is a business. The proper preparation and presentation tells the world that you are ready to face the difficult task of getting your work out there to the public, selling it to the public, and collecting the admiration and praise.

You will learn:

- 1. Which mat board/glazing material is best and how is it used differently on different types of paintings.
- 2. Why the way paintings are hung is different in a gallery.
- 3. How to mount your work in the frame.
- 4. Adhesives: the evils of acids and where they are found.
- 5. Why "good enough" framing can be the death of your art career.
- 6. More secrets to Show Framing.

Bring several different kinds and see how they work differently. (watercolor, yupo, etc); Oil Pastels: I like Holbein, but you can bring anything you have or just buy a cheap set to try out BRING SEVERAL DARKS AND SEVERAL LIGHTS; "Spreaders" BRING: old credit card, plastic icing spreader or car putty spreader: anything like that. Bring several different kinds!; Single razor (in protective device) if you have one; Newspaper to cover the table, baby wipes to clean your hands.
