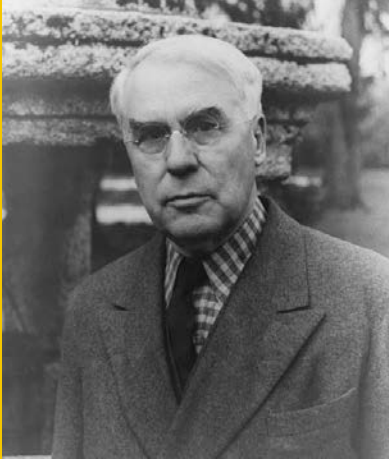

Jayne Yantz has been teaching full-time at BCC since 2000, and has been recognized for her teaching several times, including an award from Burlington County College for Teacher of the Year. She received her Master's in Art History from Ohio State University and went on for three years of Ph.D. work at the University of Delaware. She also did a mid-career fellowship at Princeton. She has done work in both European and Non-Western Art.



The class will cover the Barnes Foundation: his life and his dreams of making art affordable for all. Albert Coombs Barnes (January 2, 1872 – July 24, 1951) was an American physician and chemist, businessman, art collector, writer, and educator and the founder of the Barnes Foundation in Lower Merion, Pennsylvania.
